	Achieve a composite score of 60 or above on the ATI TEAS exam (The ATI TEAS update is scheduled August 30, 2016. The TEAS V test score will no longer be accepted following the spring 2017 enrollment class. Thereafter, on the new TEAS test will be recognized. (Check nursing website regarding TEAS Registration, Testing, and Remediation.
	Achieve a composite score of 18 or above on the ACT (Enhanced Version Only - Fall of 1989 or later). A score of less than 18, can be waived by successfully completing 24 semester hours of degree-required courses (including A&P I, II and Microbiology) with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
	Achieve a GPA of 2.5 or higher on required pre-requisite courses, plus any other degree- required nursing courses completed.
Applied Baccala	RN Transitional student, post-professional BS degree conferred student, or students with conferred Health –related Associate of Science Degrees are waived the 5 year timed-out policy required for Science Courses (A&P I, II & Microbiology). (A post ureate-Degree student is defined as a student who currently holds a bachelor's degree and is now pursuing the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing)
	After successful completion of the above requirements (excluding NUR 1116, SPT 1113, SOC 2113, and the ter Competency), the student may submit the application for Program Admission. Or , the student may elect to te all non-nursing courses prior to making application. Applications are submitted to a Nursing Counselor at the npus.
	Application Deadline: May 15 th (Applications accepted beginning April 1st)
