Register for and successfully complete Core Courses/Prerequisites (Maintaining a 2.5 GPA)
Radiology Technology Program Core Courses/Prerequisite Information Academic core courses are: College Algebra, A & P I and II, English Composition I, Social/Behavioral Science elective, Humanities/Fine Arts elective, and Public Speaking. Four of the following courses (excluding the 3 hour College Computer Competency) must be completed before making application to the program, with one of the courses being Anatomy & Physiology I lecture and lab.
ENG 1113 (English Composition I) BIO 2514 (Human Anatomy & Physiology I)
Social/Behavioral Science Elective BIO 2524 (Human Anatomy & Physiology II)
Humanities/Fine Arts Elective SPT 1113 (Public Speaking)
MAT 1313 College Algebra 3 hour College Computer Competency
Complete at least 4 of the program's Academic Core courses. One of the 4 courses must be Anatomy & Physiology I.
Attend a <i>Mandatory</i> Pre-Allied Health Orientation Session (Check Program website for dates & times)
Register for and successfully complete the HESI A2 Exam (Check Radiologic Technology website regarding Registration, Testing, Remediation, and Re-testing
Achieve a minimum composite score of 18 or above on the ACT (Enhanced Version - Fall of 1989 or later). A score of less than 18 will not be accepted and cannot be waived.
Achieve a GPA of 2.5 on College work with no grade less than "C" on any academic core courses.
Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for the Campus Police testing times.
After successful completion of all academic and entry requirements, the student may submit an Allied Health Application for Program Admission beginning January 15 th of each year. Please meet with a counselor of the Jackson County Campus to submit and complete your Radiologic Technology Program Application Packet.
