- _____ Applicant must be a Nationally Registered EMT; If not held previously, students must obtain state EMT certification after admission into the program
- _____ Successfully complete (70% or better) the EMT-Basic Review Exam (*See website for registration information*)
- _____ Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for the Campus Police testing times.
- _____ **Prior to the deadline, but after successful completion of the above program entry requirements, submit the supplemental EMS/Paramedic Application. (See website for steps on submitting the application). Contact an Enrollment Specialist at a campus of your choice for additional questions.**
