

STEP-BY-STEP APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR THE Respiratory Care Technology STUDENT

- _____ Complete the MGCCC College Admission Requirements
- _____ Visit the Respiratory Care Technology Program Website page (located under Programs of Study/Health Sciences).
- _____ Review and Complete the **Mandatory** Pre-Health Sciences Orientation Session (*See website to access*)

Register for and successfully complete the following Prerequisites

- _____ Complete **BIO 2514** Anatomy & Physiology I and **BIO 2524** Anatomy & Physiology II.
- _____ Have a minimum cumulative (GPA) of 2.5 on college work with no grade less than "C" on any Academic Core* courses in the current RCT curriculum. (Courses may be re-taken and highest score will be used).

* Academic Core courses include: BIO 2514, BIO 2524, ENG 1113, SPT 1113, a Humanities/ Fine Arts Elective and a Social /Behavioral Science Elective.
- _____ Achieve a minimum composite score of 18 or above on the ACT (Enhanced Version - Fall of 1989 or later).
A score of less than 18 will not be accepted and cannot be waived.
- _____ Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for the Campus Police testing times.
- _____ **Prior to the deadline, but after successful completion of the above program entry requirements, submit the supplemental Respiratory Care Technology Application. (See website for steps on submitting the application). Contact an Enrollment Specialist at a campus of your choice for additional questions.**

Application Deadline: July 1st (Applications accepted beginning April 15th)

(If deadline falls on a weekend, holiday, or college closing, the deadline is 5 p.m. on the next college business day).
