ENG 1113 (English Composition I) BIO 2514 (Human Anatomy & Physiology I) PSY 1513 (General Psychology) BIO 2924 (Microbiology)
The following Courses are additional Non-Nursing courses that may be taken after making application to the program. However, it is strongly encouraged to complete prior to submitting the application to enter.
BIO 2524 (Human Anatomy & Physiology II)ENG 1123 (English Composition II)SOC 2113 (Introduction to Sociology)SPT 1113 (Public Speaking)3 hour computer course (Required until fall 2014)EPY 2533 (Human Growth & Development)
Science Courses (A&P I, II & Microbiology) must be less than 5 years old <u>unless</u> applicant is a LPN to RN Transitional student, is a post professional BS degree conferred student, or has a conferred Health –related Associate of Applied Science Degree. (A post Baccalaureate-Degree student is defined as a student who currently holds a bachelor's degree and is now pursuing the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing)
Attend a <i>Mandatory</i> Pre-Nursing Orientation Session (Check Nursing website for dates & times)
Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for the Campus Police testing times.
Achieve a composite score of 60 or above on the ATI TEAS exam (The ATI TEAS update is scheduled August 30, 2016. The TEAS V test score will no longer be accepted following the spring 2017 enrollment class. Thereafter, only the new TEAS test will be recognized. (Check nursing website regarding TEAS Registration, Testing, and Remediation.
Achieve a composite score of 18 or above on the ACT (Enhanced Version - Fall of 1989 or later). An ACT (Enhanced Version) score of less than 18, can be waived by successfully completing 24 semester hours of degree-required courses (including A&P I, II and Microbiology) with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
Achieve a GPA of 2.5 or higher on required pre-requisite courses, plus any other degree-required nursing courses completed.
After successful completion of the above requirements (excluding BIO 2524, ENG 1123, SPT 1113, SOC 2113, EPY 2533, and the computer Competency), the student may submit the application for Program Admission. Or , the student may elect to complete all non-nursing courses prior to making application. <u>SPT 1113 & SOC 2113 are not required if the student selects the PN Exit Option</u> .
Applications are submitted to a Nursing Counselor at the JD, JC, Perkinston or George County Campus or Center.
Fall Semester Application Deadline: July 1 st (Applications accepted beginning April 15 ^{th)} Spring Semester Application Deadline: November 1 st (Applications accepted beginning August 15 ^{th)}
